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WAIVER AND CONSENT FORM

- The Camp PAWS scholarship form is designed for families in financial need. **By completing this application, you are agreeing that your family is in need of financial assistance in order to provide your child a chance to participate in the program and would otherwise not be able to attend.**
- Camp PAWS scholarships are awarded for the full registration fee. Awarded applicants will not receive funds but will be registered in the program free of cost. At most, one scholarship per camp season will be awarded.
- Camp participants will come into contact with soy, milk, nut and wheat products.
- All camp participants are required to wear closed toed shoes for their safety. Camp participants who arrive with open toed shoes will not be allowed to participate.
- All Humane Society of Huron Valley Camp PAWS participants will interact with animals on a daily basis. Animals may include (but are not limited to) dogs, cats, rabbits, guinea pigs, cows, horses, goats, ducks, lizards, ferrets. HSHV cannot discriminate which animals participants interact with during the camp. Requests for participants to not engage with certain animals cannot be honored.
- Families will be responsible for providing a lunch and drink for their child for each day of camp. Refrigerators and microwaves will not be available for lunches, so please plan accordingly. HSHV will provide a daily snack for Camp PAWS participants around 2:30pm. Snacks will consist of crackers, pretzels, etc.
- Camp PAWS sessions run from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday – Friday. Camp participants should not arrive before 8:50 a.m. All camp participants are to be picked up promptly at 4:00 p.m. HSHV does not have the staff to care for campers after camp hours. A \$25 fee will apply for any campers picked up after 4:10 p.m. In case of late pickup, emergency contacts will immediately be contacted. Camp participants will not be released to any person who is not listed under the emergency contacts. Proper picture ID will be required for anyone picking up a camp participant. The scholarship does not cover after care.
- Camp participants who bring cell phones with them to Camp PAWS should expect to use their phones only to contact parents in case of an emergency. Calling or texting during camp activities will not be permitted.
- While allowing time with shelter animals is an important part of Camp PAWS, time with our adoptable animals is very limited and closely monitored. Camp participants will have daily opportunities to interact with a variety of animals, including shelter animals and visiting guests, but should not expect to spend significant amounts of time with animals waiting for adoption.
- All Humane Society of Huron Valley Camp PAWS participants are expected to display safe, respectful and appropriate behavior at all times towards staff, volunteers, guests, other camp participants and animals. Behavior guidelines and expectations will be reviewed with camp participants on the first day of camp. If a camp participant is consistently unable to abide by these expectations and guidelines, he/she may be dismissed from Camp PAWS for the day or for the remainder of the camp session. HSHV reserves the right to deny participation to any camper who exhibits unsafe behavior with staff, camp participants or animals at any time.

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- Scholarships are not transferrable and only will be applied to the applied for camp season.
